

SELLER REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS FOR AGREEMENTS UNDER U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS

Olin Winchester, LLC ("Buyer") provides products and services to the U.S. Government ("Government") under multiple prime contracts. Buyer's Government contracts impose important compliance obligations on Buyer and its suppliers (each a "Seller"). Buyer obtains these Seller Representations and Certifications to ensure that its suppliers can meet the requirements of Buyer's Government contracts. Buyer relies on the responses to these Seller Representations and Certifications in awarding purchase orders, subcontracts, and other agreements ("Agreements").

Seller must provide all information requested in these Seller Representations and Certifications and acknowledge each representation and certification by checking the relevant box. Italicized terms are defined in Federal Acquisition Regulation ("FAR") 2.101 and the FAR clauses referenced in the headings of these Seller Representations and Certifications. Buyer expects Seller to consult the referenced FAR clauses to ensure the accuracy and completeness of all responses.

These Seller Representations and Certifications will be incorporated by reference in all current and future Agreements between Seller and Buyer. Seller must provide immediate written notice to Buyer of any changes to the information provided by submitting updated Seller Representations and Certifications to Buyer.
